Orthopaedic Profile:-

I have been in post as Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon/ Honorary Senior Lecturer at the University Hospital South Manchester for the last 17 years.

The bulk of my planned surgical work revolves around reconstructive procedures in the knee including keyhole surgery, ligament reconstruction, biomechanical realignment procedures, partial, total and revision knee replacement.

I provide a general on-call emergency service for the main Major Trauma Centre in Manchester, covering a large area of the North West of England. I work closely with the plastic and reconstructive surgeons at my base Hospital in the joint management of serious trauma.

I accept internal and external referral of complex lower limb trauma.

I am responsible for the training and teaching of undergraduate and postgraduate students in the field of Orthopaedics, trauma and in particular disorders of the knee.

In addition to my clinical duties, I was the Clinical Director for the Orthopaedic department from 2005 to 2012.

One of my interests out of medicine is software authoring. I have personally created the Trauma Unit patient management database currently used for management and research of our trauma intake, throughout the hospital.

I am well published in peer-reviewed journals over a wide range of conditions, mainly in Lower limb reconstruction.

I practice privately from rooms at The Beeches Consulting Centre, and The Alexandra Hospital, Mill Lane, Cheadle.

Medico-legal Experience:-

As a full-time practising Orthopaedic Surgeon, I have provided more than 1000 medicolegal reports covering a wide area injury and Orthopaedic related conditions. I have extensive experience in the field of trauma and reconstruction, having practised as a senior clinician since 1995.

The majority of these reports relate to personal injury spanning minor to severe limb and life-threatening conditions as a result of trauma.

I have also provided clinical negligence opinions within my sphere of specialist interest in surgical reconstruction of the injured knee. I have frequently been instructed to give specific occupational opinions related to the consequences of moderate to severe injury as a result of general and sports related trauma.

It has always been my philosophy to provide as accurate and unbiased a report as possible and I consider it essential to provide clear and unambiguous reporting to assist the legal professionals.

Even prior to the Woolf reforms, most of my medico legal instructions were as single expert. Where the situation has arisen, I have engaged in conference and joint statement production and I am comfortable with this process.

I am familiar with the current requirements, terminology and framework of modern medico legal reporting including the recent Jackson reforms with respect to expert evidence.

I have received positive feedback over my style of reporting and I have used requested clarifications as a means of continuing to improve my medical reports.
